As the Public Information (PI) Chairperson for Louisiana Area 27 the primary goal is to continue to bring public information to the still suffering alcoholic. Each area assembly the PI chair person is to chair a meeting during the assembly come up with a plan for the 2 year service period. The meeting is based on reviewing the PI work book as well as assisting the PI committees in the area with ideas and strategies to deliver the message for the still suffering alcoholic.

The use of delivering a message thru radio, television, newspapers, and the web for search engines, bill boards and telephone books for hotlines are possibilities of different ways a PI committee can work. Also information can be brought to libraries, schools, police stations, drug court, doctors, churches, counselors, parole officers, motels, hotels, and any other place information is provided for people to collect.

The PI committee Chair also is expected to go to the State Convention and participate in speaking about PI to Districts or workshops in the state.

The Committee chair provides a report during Area Assembly and stays to participate as a voting member for the business meeting. Finally, the Chair submits a proposed budget to B&F chair by October 15 of each year.
