

## 2010 Agenda Items

### **February:**

#### **Passed:**

Approve the 2010 budget

Motion to discontinue the registration fee

Continue to provide lunch with a suggested donation of \$5.

Propose that the Assembly visit other areas of the state to present orientation on the Assembly.

#### **Failed:**

The basket passed during the speaker meeting on Saturday be earmarked for hospitality

### **May:**

**Passed:** Propose that the proposed Area Assembly Guidelines be accepted by the Assembly.

Motion to have our first quarter Assembly be dedicated to the pre-General Service Conference activities and to adjust the date of the assembly, as needed, in order to have sufficient time to distribute the agenda background material, as well as giving groups time to consider the agenda items and background material.

Propose that Area 27 form District 24 as a Spanish linguistic district with full rights and privileges and responsibilities at the Area Committee and the Area Assembly

Motion to grant Archives Committee permission to raise their own funds and rent facility for housing of our archives, funds to be administered and handled by Area 27 treasurer

Propose that District 10, 11, 14A, 14B, 15A, 15B, and 15D be allowed to elect a DCMC with full participation and voting rights in the Area Committee and Area Assembly

**November:**

Propose a one time \$800 increase in the 2010 budget for committee chair expenses
